

Alutiiq Beaded Earrings



SUPPLIES:

Nymo Beading Thread 240 Seed Beads 40 Larger Faceted Beads 2 Earring Hooks Scissors Beading Needle Paper Towel or Bead Mat Needle-nose Pliers Super Glue (optional)

Step One: Prepare Your Materials

- 1. Lay out your paper towel or bead mat.
- 2. Sort your beads by size and color. It can be helpful to pour some into a small dish or plate.
- 3. Measure and cut out a 36" long length of thread.
 - a. Thread your needle.
 - b. DO NOT tie any knots.

Step Two: Begin Beading (Tassel One)

- 1. String 2 of the larger beads and leave at least a 6-inch tail of thread. These beads will be the top of your earring.
- 2. Add 20 seed beads. Double count to be exact.
- 3. String 1 large bead.
- 4. Add 5 large beads.
 - a. Use 2 of one color, 1 of a different color, and then 2 more of the first color.
 - b. These will create a loop at the bottom of your earring.
- 5. Bring the needle up through the bottom bead to make the 5 bead loop.

Step Two: (Continued)

- 6. String 20 more of the seed beads.
 - a. Double check your count to make sure you have the correct number of seed beads.
 - b. Thread your needle through the top 2 large beads.
 - c. Make sure you have at least a 6-inch tail of thread.
- 7. Attach the earring hook to the thread.
 - a. Make sure the earring hook is secured shut so the thread cannot pass through it.
 - b. Use needle-nose pliers to pinch the loop at the bottom on the earring hook.
 - c. Thread the needle through the eye of the hook.

Step Three: Continue Beading (Tassels Two & Three)

- 1. Pull the needle and thread back down through the top two (large) beads.
- 2. Repeat Step Two to create the second tassel.
 - a. Keep the beads tight as you go.
 - b. Each time you complete a tassel and go back to the top of the earring, thread the needle through the earring hook eye and down through the top two large beads.
- 3. Repeat Step Two to create the third tassel.

Step Four: Finish the Earrings

- 1. When you finish the third tassel, pull the needle and thread through the eye of the earring hook one more time and then tie a double knot with the threads.
- 2. Flip the earring over and tie another double knot.
- 3. Make sure everything is knotted securely.
- 4. Pull the thread tails down through the top 2 (large) beads.
 - a. Thread each of the ends back into one string of 20 (seed) beads to secure.
 - b. Do this to both tails.
- 5. Pull on the tail and earring hook and closely cut the tail.
- 6. Optional: use a small dot of super glue to secure the knot at the earring hook.

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
