DIRECTION 1: Advance Cultural Stewardship

Connect audiences with the heritage and living culture of the Alutiiq/Sugpiaq people–locally, regionally, statewide, nationally, and internationally.

- Support language revitalization, research, and education.
- Expand opportunities for all Alutiiq people to learn, share, and celebrate Alutiiq history, language, and culture, including village residents and members of the Alutiiq diaspora.
- Enhance participation in learning about Alutiiq history, language, and living culture for our entire audience.
- Make Alutiiq culture and history an integral part of the K-12 education in our region.
- Enhance the care of collections and opportunities for engagement with material culture.
- Lead and support archaeological research to document Alutiiq history.
- Create resources that provide accurate, accessible information on the Alutiiq world.

The Alutiiq Museum preserves and shares the heritage and living culture of the Alutiiq people.

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DIRECTION 3: Operate a World Class Museum

Enhance the museum's infrastructure to sustain and advance our mission and act as a leader in tribal museum practice.
