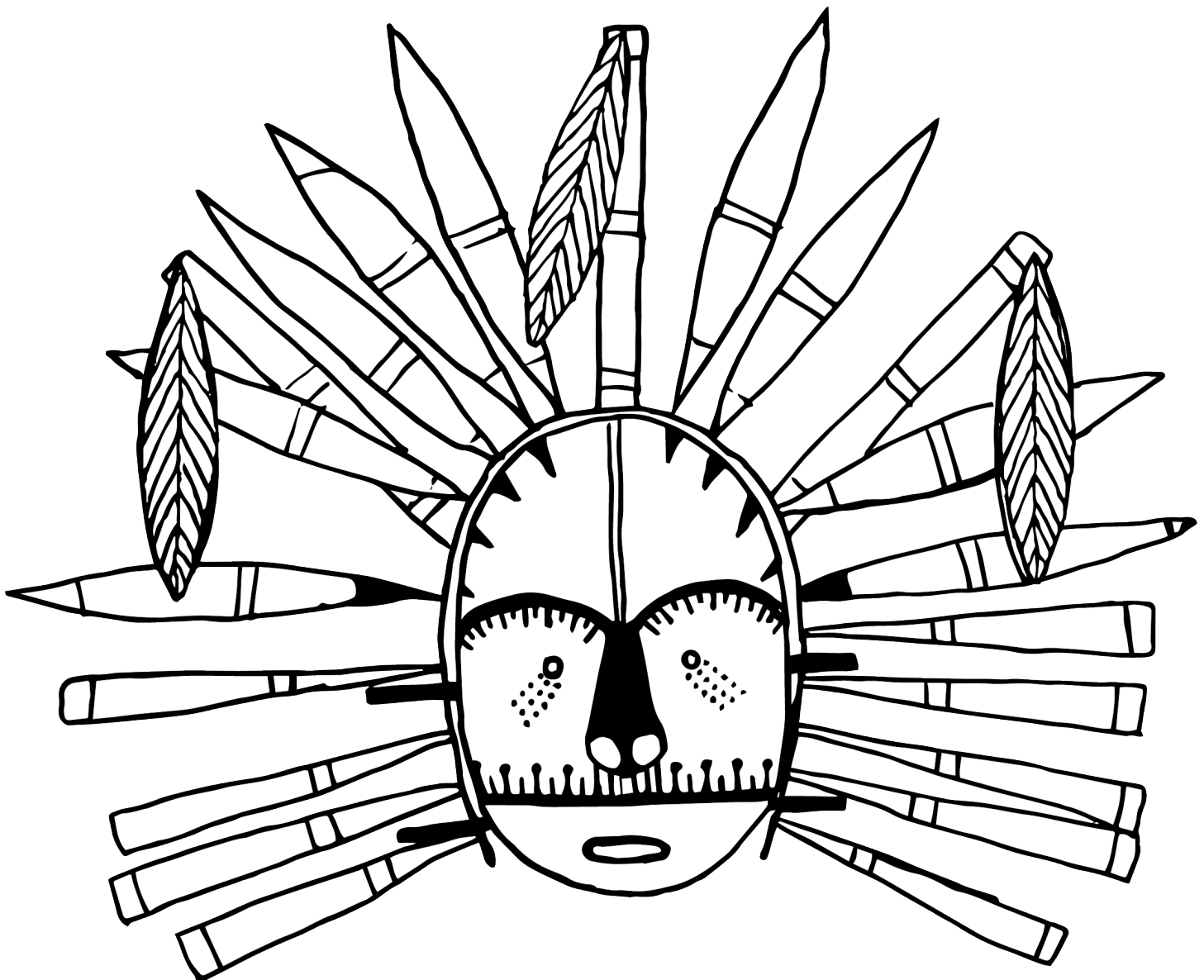
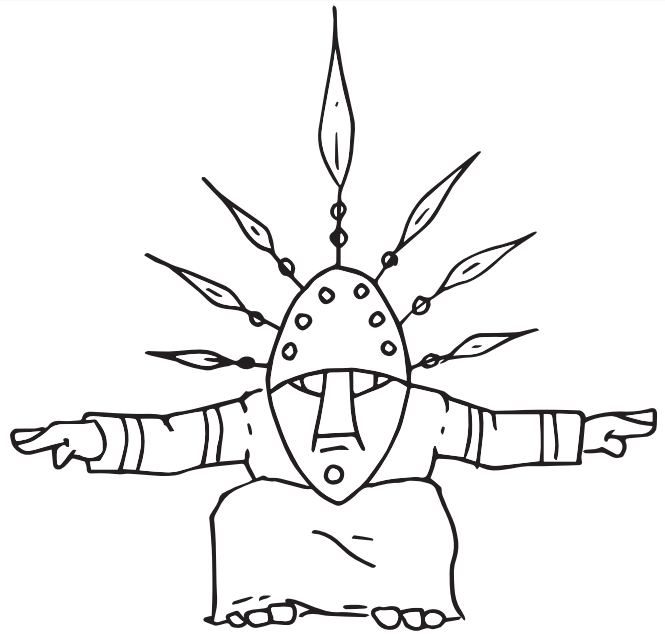


Giinaruat – Masks

Alutiiq people carved and decorated masks to wear at winter festivals. Dancers wore masks to call animal spirits and thank them for providing food. Each mask was unique.
