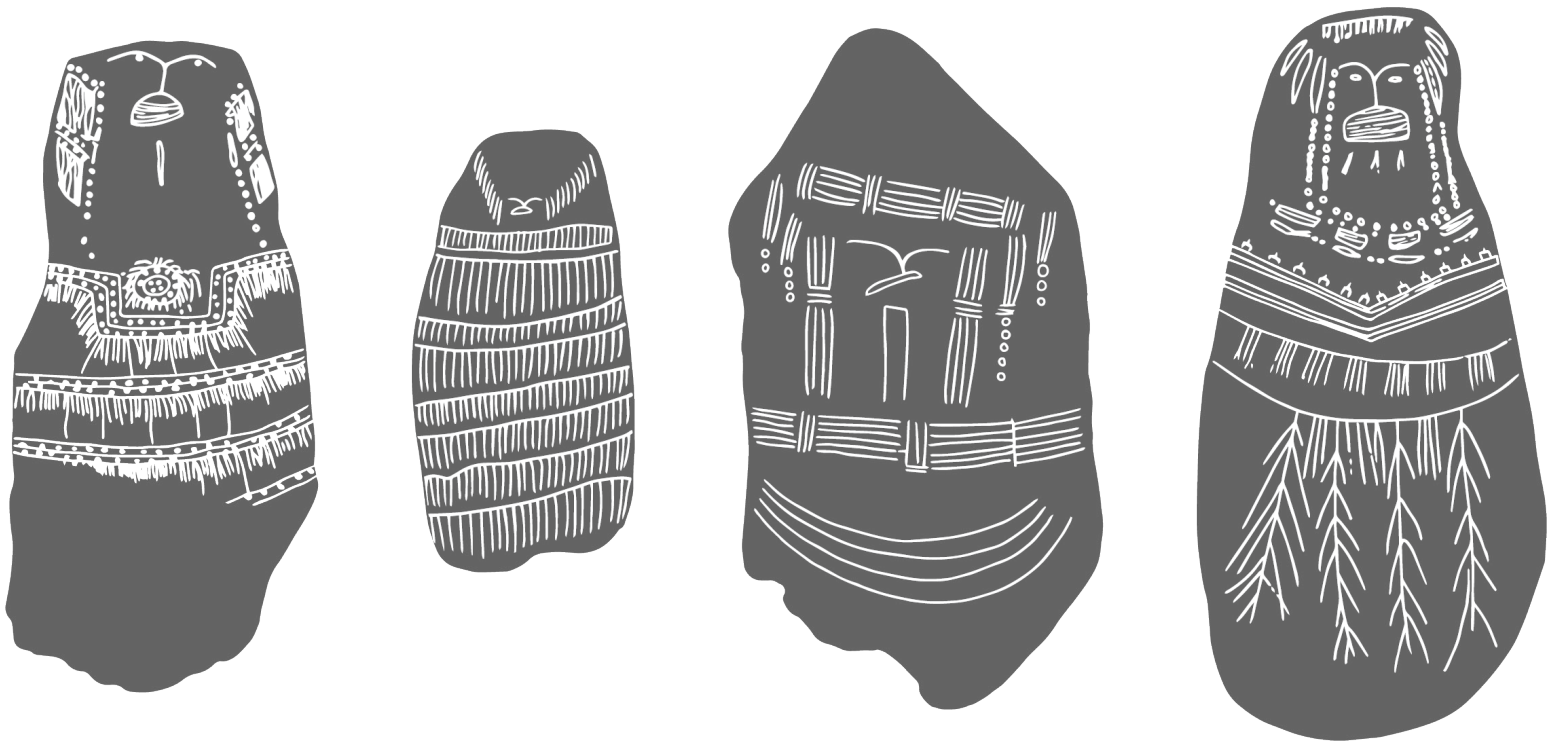


# Yaamat Igarua'it – Pebble Drawings

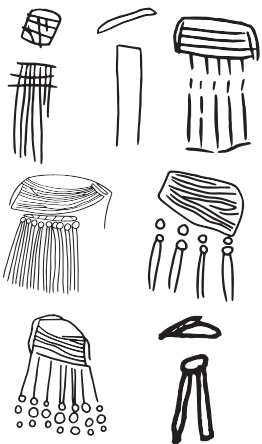


We collected the symbols from many pebble drawings.

## Ears and earrings



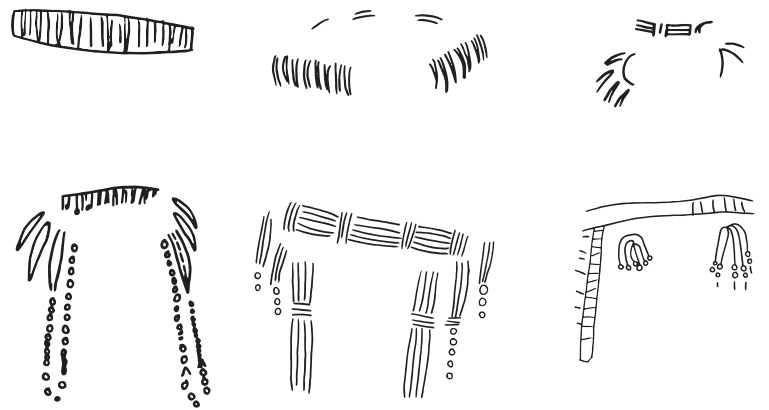
## Labrets and chin tattoos



## Mouths

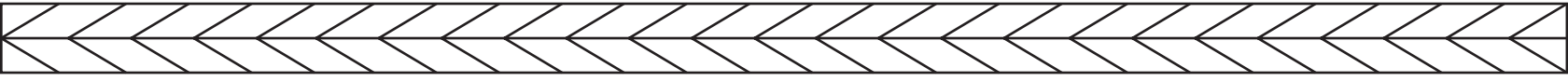

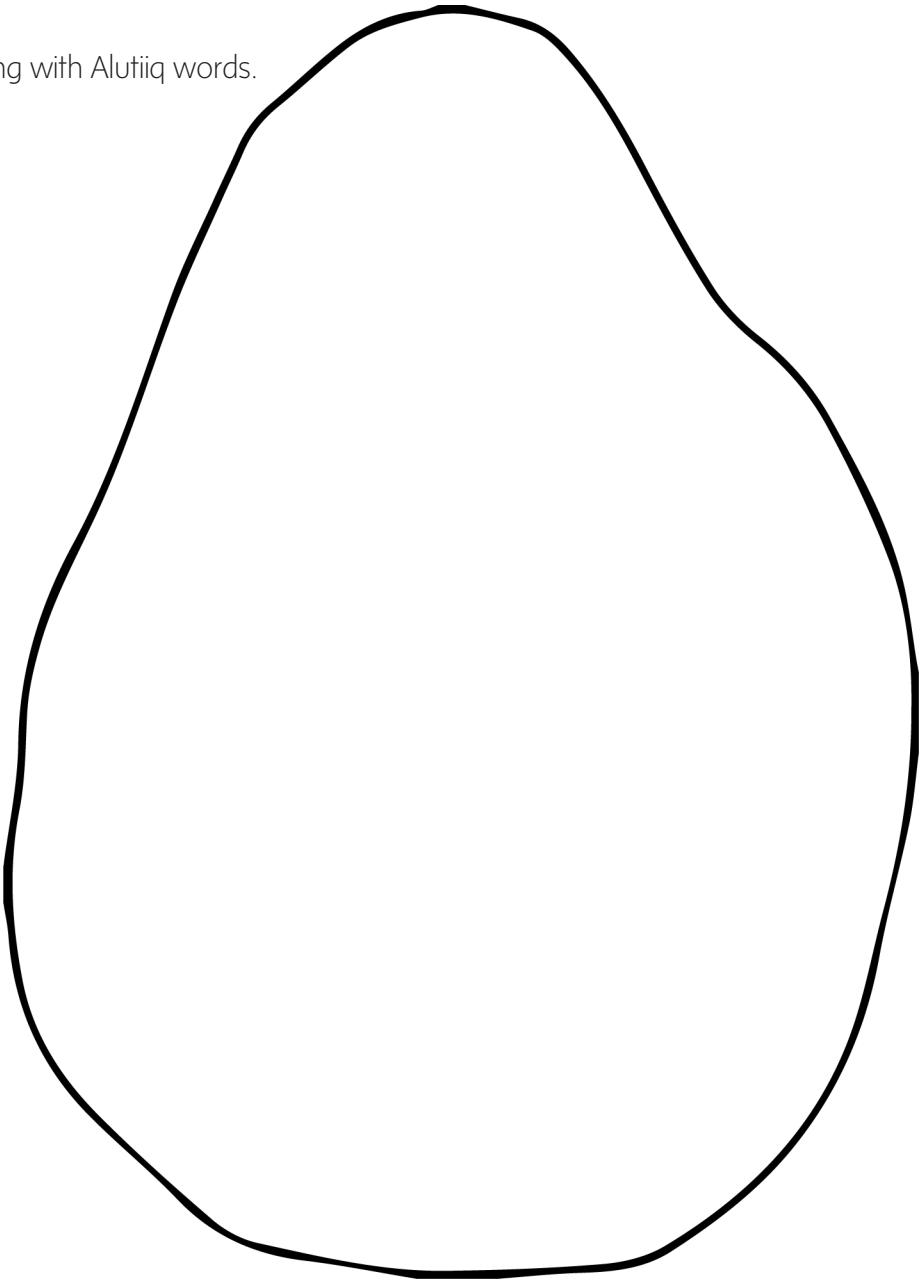


# Gui – Me
