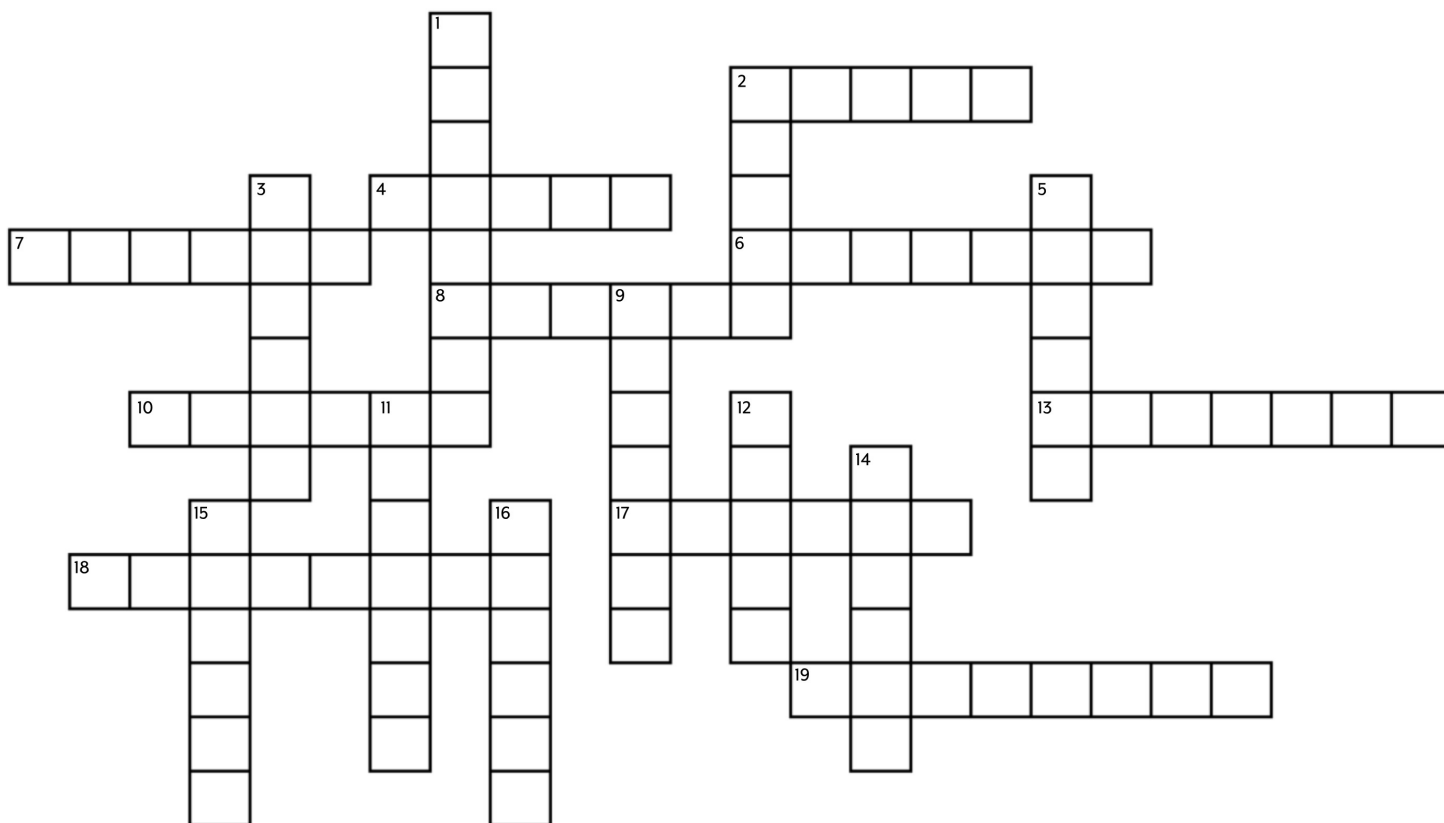

5. Edible bulbs/roots from a plant with a stinky brown flower
9. A black mollusk collected at low-tide, eaten raw
11. Eaten smoked, dried, baked, or fried
12. Some are white, others are spotted, they can all be scrambled
14. A favorite berry for *akutaq*, but might leave a purple stain
15. A fat, playful sea mammal
16. A delicious dessert made with berries, oil, and sugar

2. A green, spiny treat collected at low tide
4. Eaten as steaks, roasts, and burgers, or added to stew
6. A berry with a sour smell
7. In southern Kodiak, a favorite treat eaten with butter and jam
